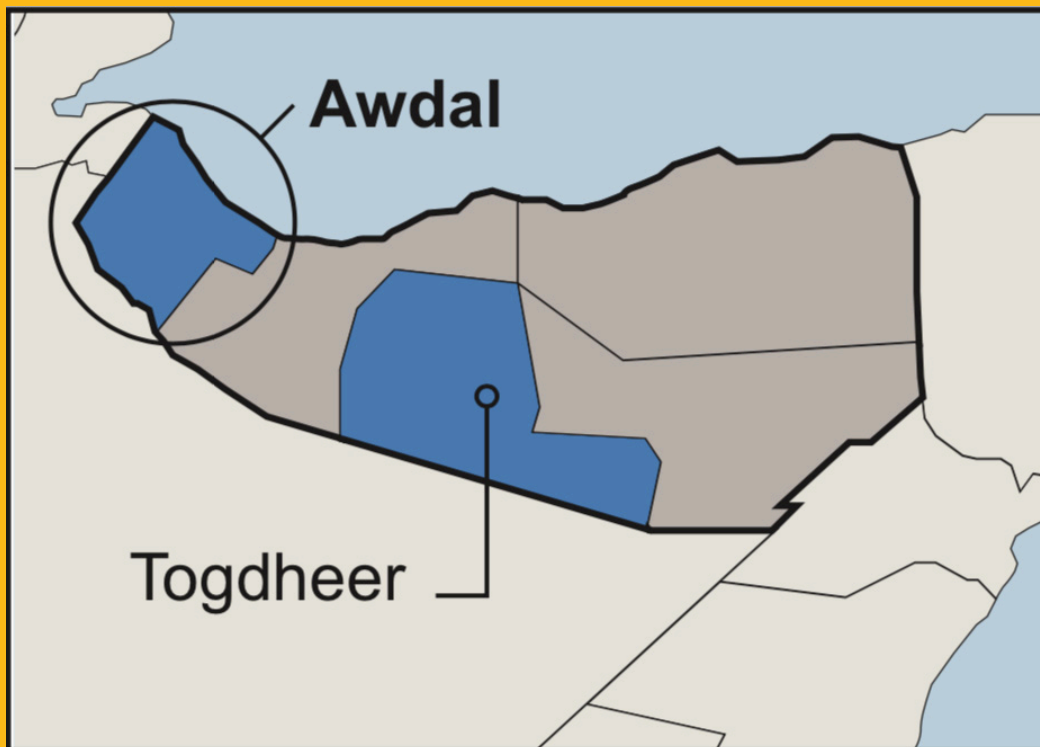

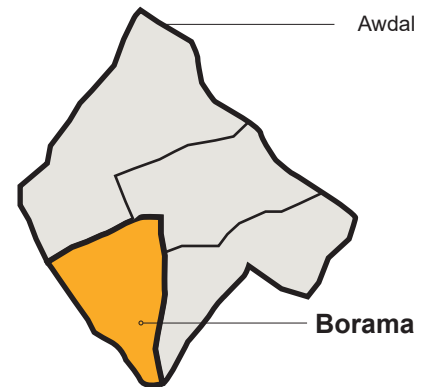
SHINE Supply Factsheet: Borama District, Awdal Region

What is SHINE Supply?

SHINE Supply (2018-2021) is a component of the UK aid-funded Somali Health and Nutrition (SHINE) programme. SHINE aims to reduce mother and child deaths in Somalia and Somaliland by improving health and nutrition services. The SHINE Supply component mainly focuses on delivering an Essential Package of Health Services (EPHS), together with some health systems strengthening (HSS) initiatives.¹

SHINE Supply in Borama District

Borama District is in Awdal Region, Somaliland, and has an estimated population of 475,960.² Its economy centres on pastoralism, agriculture and trade. SHINE Supply's principal implementing partner in Borama District is Health Poverty Action (HPA). HPA works closely with the District Health Management Team to support EPHS delivery in health facilities across Borama District. It also supports nutrition and outreach services, ambulance services, and contributes to HSS activities.

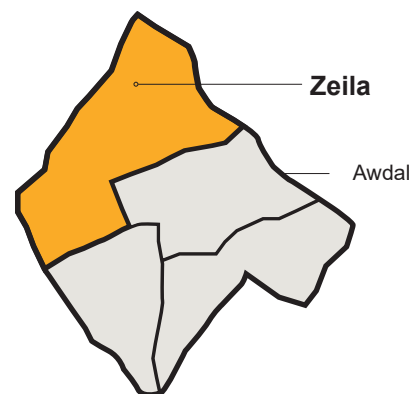
Zeila District, Awdal Region

HPA works closely with District Health Teams to support EPHS delivery in health facilities across Zeila District. It also supports nutrition and outreach services, ambulance services, and contributes to HSS activities.
