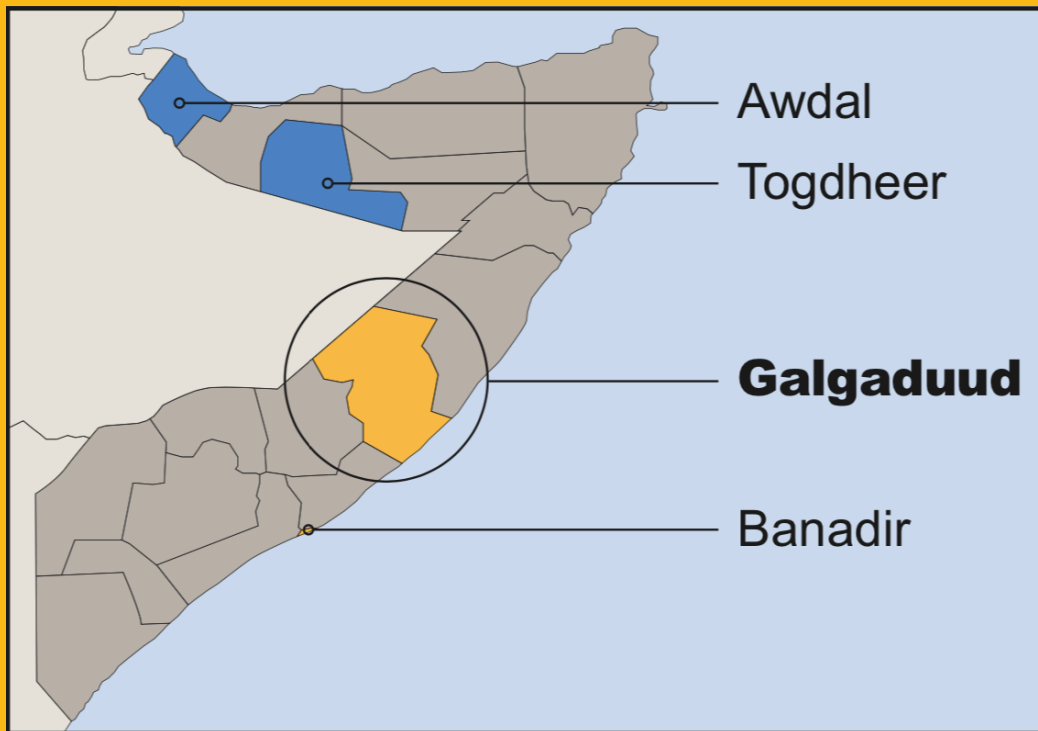

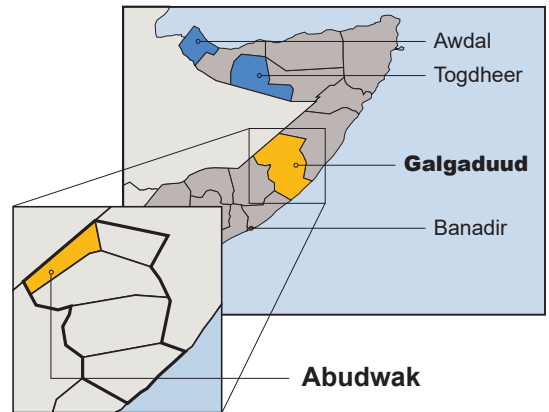
## Abudwak District, Galgaduud Region

### What is SHINE Supply?

SHINE Supply (2018-2021) is a component of the UK aid-funded Somali Health and Nutrition (SHINE) programme. SHINE aims to reduce mother and child deaths in Somalia and Somaliland by improving health and nutrition services. The SHINE Supply component mainly focuses on delivering an Essential Package of Health Services (EPHS), together with some health systems strengthening (HSS) initiatives.<sup>1</sup>

### SHINE Supply in Abudwak District

Abudwak District is in Galgaduud Region, Somalia. It has an estimated population of 91,893.<sup>2</sup> SHINE Supply's lead implementing partner in Abudwak District is Mercy USA. Mercy USA works with the District Health Team to support EPHS delivery in 13 health facilities across Abudwak and Balanbale Districts. It also supports outreach teams, extensive nutrition and community engagement activities, and wider HSS.

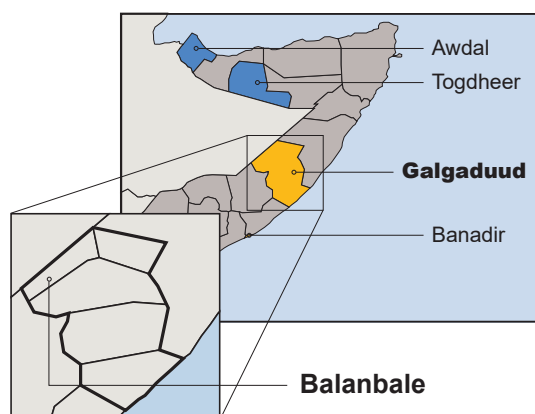
# SHINE Supply Factsheet: Balanbale District, Galgaduud Region

Mercy USA works with the District Health Team to support EPHS delivery in 13 health facilities across Balanbale and Abudwak Districts. It also supports outreach teams, extensive nutrition and community engagement activities, and wider HSS.
