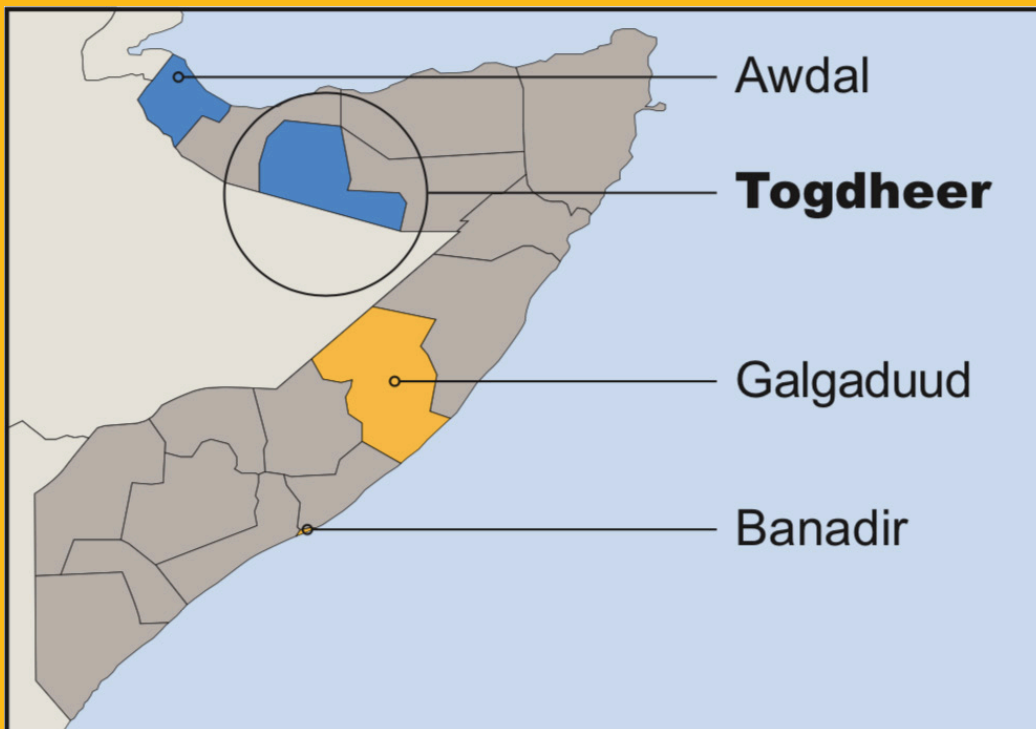

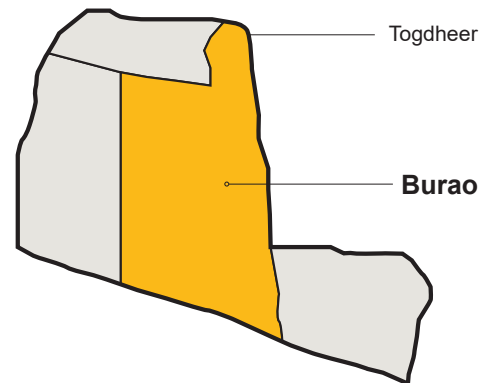
SHINE Supply Factsheet: Burao District, Togdheer Region

What is SHINE Supply?

SHINE Supply (2018-2021) is a component of the UK aid-funded Somali Health and Nutrition (SHINE) programme. SHINE aims to reduce mother and child deaths in Somalia and Somaliland by improving health and nutrition services. The SHINE Supply component mainly focuses on delivering an Essential Package of Health Services (EPHS), together with some health systems strengthening (HSS) initiatives.¹

SHINE Supply in Burao District

Burao District is in Togdheer Region, Somaliland, and has an estimated population of 460,131 inhabitants.² SHINE Supply's lead implementing partner in Burao District is Health Poverty Action (HPA). HPA works closely with the District Health Team to support EPHS delivery in health facilities across Burao District. This includes: support for mobile clinics; nutrition, outreach and referral services; and wider HSS activities.

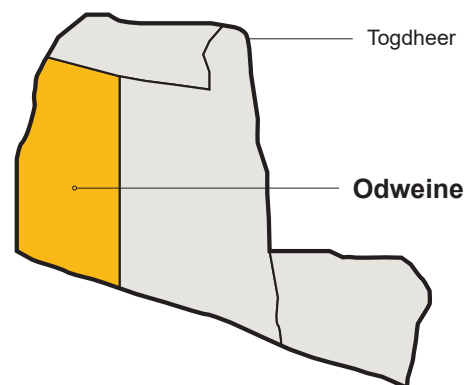

This includes: support for mobile clinics; nutrition, outreach and referral services; and wider HSS activities.
